
FP7 overview (2007-2013)

- Complementary Funding to BION ?
- 25 M Euros in 2008
- Science based projects
- Exchanges of staff (including junior researchers)
- 1 12 months long
- Mobility from EU to Russia and Russia to EU
- stipend 1800 Euros/month
- No coverage for travel, etc...

Marie Curie Action International Research Staff Exchange Scheme

- Deadline 19 March 2009
- Incoming expenses must be justified
- Proposal requirements:
 - joint programme as basis for collaboration
 - joint research and training activities; joint workshops and seminars; networking activities
 - exploit complementary expertise; create synergies between them
 - additional benefits for the participants in terms of transfer of knowledge
- Coordinator: EU country

Evaluation of proposals	May 2008
Evaluation Summary Reports sent to proposal coordinators ("initial information letter")	June 2008
Invitation letter to successful coordinators to launch contract negotiations with Commission services	July 2008
Letter to unsuccessful applicants	From July 2008
Signature of first contracts	From October 2008
